What can I do to help with redness, irritation, and swelling?

After you are done the treatment, try these tips to help with redness, irritation and swelling:

- Soak the area with a warm wash cloth for 5-10 minutes 2-3 times a day
- Use moisturizers such as Vaseline®, Eucerin®, Aquaphor® or other similar creams

What can I expect my skin to look like after the treatment?

The pictures below show how the skin will likely look after the treatment. The first 2 pictures show the skin right after treatment. The last picture shows the skin 2 weeks after the treatment. Please keep in mind these skin changes can vary from person to person.







When should I call my doctor?
